Subject: Request for access to information

I am writing in reply to your request for access to information a copy of which I received last May 8. In it, you expressed the desire to have "information requesting of you any and all records related to the payment of Facebook ads or any other forms of advertising by the protecteur du citoyen , and any and all records regarding the sponsored ads made by the protecteur du citoyen Facebook account or any other social media accounts. I request those records for the last 10 years including the current one." (sic)

This request concerns the right to access documents held by a public body in accordance with section 9 of the *Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*, hereinafter referred to as the "Act."

Decision

In reply to your request, here are the amounts allocated for publicity on social media in the past 10 years:

\$455.81 in 2013-2014

\$863.63 in 2014-2015

\$715.28 in 2015-2016

\$1,267.79 in 2016-2017

\$2,146.17 in 2017-2018

Lastly, I would inform you that, in accordance with sections 51, 135 and 137 of the Act, you may apply, in writing, to the Commission d'accès à l'information (contact information below) for a review of my decision within 30 days of its date, briefly stating why you disagree with the decision.
